In addition, the successful applicant will be expected to teach in the College's rapidly growing MPH program, participate in the PhD program in Epidemiology, contribute to the mission and vision of a rapidly growing Department and College, collaborate with other faculty within the College and Health Sciences Center, and build on strong research traditions of UF while addressing key Public Health issues in the state of Florida and the southeast region.

The College of Public Health and Health Professions currently hosts several major centers devoted to the study of health related issues, including the Brooks Center for Rehabilitation Studies, the National Rural Behavioral Health Center, the Center for Telehealth and Healthcare Communications, the Florida Center for Medicaid and the Uninsured, and the National Older Drivers Research and Training Center. In addition, faculty work closely with the Rehabilitation Outcomes Research Center of Excellence at the VA Medical Center and the Institute on Aging at the UF College of Medicine. The College of Public Health and Health Professions is part of the University's Health Science Center, which also includes the Colleges of Medicine, Pharmacy, Nursing, Dentistry, and Veterinary Medicine.
